FROM THE PRIEST

There are many skeptics in our world today just as there were in Jesus' time, and we hear this skepticism in today's Gospel.

In today's Gospel, John the Baptist was announcing the coming of the Messiah! But the religious leaders of that time were skeptical about who John was and how he could speak on behalf of God; was he the Messiah or trying to be one of the great prophets to announce the Messiah's coming? John only wanted to be a voice warning people to get ready for the arrival of God's Messiah!

John the Baptist is unique because he is the connection between the Old and New Testaments; John is the last of the Old Testament prophets who shows others the Messiah! John foreshadowed what the Messiah would come and do – freedom from sin and being adopted sons and daughters of God!

May we, like John the Baptist, point others to Jesus Christ, the real Messiah, and be always a true example and witness of the Gospel!

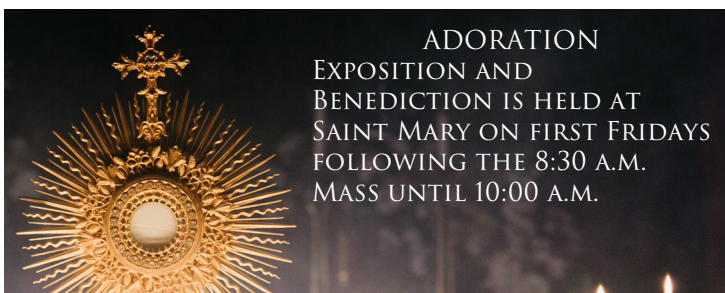

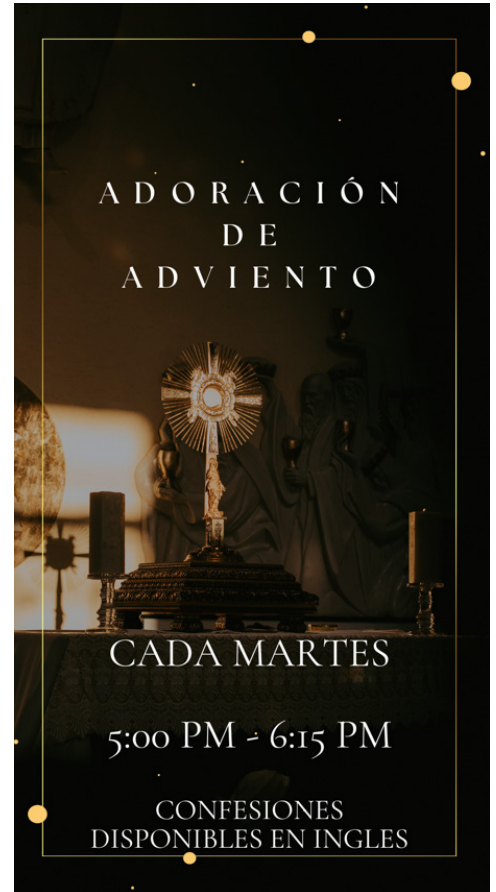
