FROM THE PRIEST

Authority.

There are many who love to have authority in our day, and that was especially true during Jesus' time on earth. When the Rabbis of Jesus' time spoke, they spoke with authority given by someone. But when Jesus spoke, He spoke the Word of God since He was THE AUTHORITY INCARNATE – He is the Word of God made flesh! And when Jesus spoke, God spoke; even the demons obeyed Him!

But this Word that was spoken by Jesus has the power to set us free and transform our lives!

For us to understand God's Word more deeply, we should look at the virtues of faith, hope and love (the theological virtues)!

Many Scripture passages speak about faith, hope and love. In Paul's Letter to the Corinthians, we hear that faith is powerful, but without love is nothing (1 Cor 13). Faith works through love and is made perfect in love because love points us to the ultimate good which is God as well as the good of our neighbor who is created in the image and likeness of God.

Hope is needed because it grounds our faith in God's promises and helps us desire for the things that are eternal rather than the things of this world!

Faith is God's free gift that guides our will to His truth and needs to be fed with the Word of God!

With the help of the Holy Spirit, our minds are open to His truth and we come to know that God loves us!

If we listen to God's Word with trust and do what Jesus asks of us, we are able to learn what God wants to teach us through His Word! May we strive to be taught by the Lord at all times, and change our minds and hearts to His Word of truth and love!

Autoridad.

Hay muchos a quienes les encanta tener autoridad en nuestros días, y eso fue especialmente cierto durante el tiempo de Jesús en la tierra. Cuando los rabinos de la época de Jesús hablaban, hablaban con autoridad dada por alguien. 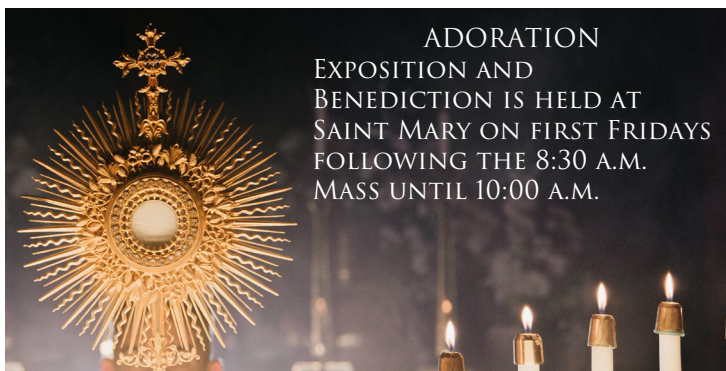

SAINT ANSGAR

Saint of the Day: February 3 | Patron Saint of: Denmark

The “apostle of the north” (Scandinavia) had enough frustrations to become a saint – and he did. He became a Benedictine at Corbie, France, where he had been educated. Three years later, when the king of Denmark became a convert, Ansgar went to that country for three years of missionary work, without noticeable success. Sweden asked for Christian missionaries, and he went there, suffering capture by pirates and other hardships on the way. Fewer than two years later, he was recalled, to become abbot of New Corbie (Corvey) and bishop of Hamburg. After 13 years work in Hamburg, Ansgar saw it burned to the ground by invading Northmen; Sweden and Denmark returned to paganism.

He directed new apostolic activities in the North, traveling to Denmark and being instrumental in the conversion of another king. By the strange device of casting lots, the king of Sweden allowed the Christian missionaries to return.

Ansgar’s biographers remark that he was an extraordinary preacher, a humble and ascetical priest. He was devoted to the poor and the sick, imitating the Lord in washing their feet and waiting on them at table. He died peacefully at Bremen, Germany.

Sweden became pagan again after his death, and remained so until the coming of missionaries two centuries later.

History records what people do, rather than what they are. Yet the courage and perseverance of men and women like Ansgar can only come from a solid base of union with the original courageous and persevering Missionary. Ansgar’s life is another reminder that God writes straight with crooked lines. Christ takes care of the effects of the apostolate in His own way; He is first concerned about the purity of the apostles themselves.
