## FROM THE PRIEST

There is much that can keep us away from God.

In the Gospel this weekend, we see Jesus “cleansing” the temple, and for Jesus’ disciples, it was seen as a sign of God’s work to “clean” and “restore” real worship and holiness with His people!

Back in the day, temples were the “dwelling place of God” with His people. We see God telling Moses how to worship Him by making a Tabernacle which became the temple of Jerusalem (Exodus 20). And in the New Testament, this is just an example of God’s true temple, which is in Heaven (Hebrews 8).

Likewise, Jesus’ cleansing of the temple is a sign of what He wants to do with all of us – He wants to clean us of sinful and harmful ways so we can be living temples of the Holy Spirit!

But Jesus had much backlash from the Jewish authorities and they wanted proof that He had authority from God, otherwise, they would say He’s a fake!

The proof of Jesus was simple – it was Himself! He is the true Temple that makes us clean and a holy people that can be with God! He would be the sign that would suffer and die on the cross and would rise on the third day!

Through Jesus’ death and Resurrection, we have been reconciled with God and have been made God’s sons and daughters and He fills us with His Holy Spirit so we can be real, living temples of our God!

In this Season of Lent, may we be aware that Jesus always wants to renew our minds and clean our hearts so we can be holy at all times and change the way we think, act and live as a son or daughter of God!

- Pray for those affected by natural disasters and acts of violence (Middle East; Ukraine; Burkina Faso; flooding and landslides out West)

- There are opportunities for Confession every Tuesday from 5:15-6:15 p.m. with Adoration and Benediction at St. Mary followed by Mass at 6:30 p.m.; Confessions are still heard 45 minutes before every weekend Mass.
- Stations of the Cross are every Friday during Lent at St. Mary’s, 7:00 p.m.
- We are participating in the 40 Days of Adoration with the diocese where different parishes throughout the diocese are having Adoration, Benediction and Confession. Our date is March 5 from 8:30 a.m. to 6:15 p.m. with Confessions at the last hour (5:15 p.m.). Sign-up sheets are in the back of the church.

## DEL SACERDOTE

*Hay muchas cosas que pueden alejarnos de Dios.*

*En el evangelio de este fin de semana, vemos a Jesús “limpiando” el templo y para los discípulos de Jesús, ¡fue visto como una señal de la obra de Dios para “limpiar” y “restaurar” la verdadera adoración y santidad con Su pueblo!*

*En el pasado, los templos eran la “vivienda de Dios” con su pueblo. Vemos a Dios diciéndole a Moisés cómo adorarlo haciendo un Tabernáculo que se convirtió en el templo de Jerusalén (Éxodo 20). Y en el Nuevo Testamento, esto es sólo un ejemplo del verdadero templo de Dios, que está en el Cielo (Hebreos 8).*

*De la misma manera, la limpieza del templo por parte de Jesús es una señal de lo que Él quiere hacer con todos nosotros: ¡Quiere limpiarnos de formas pecaminosas y dañinas para que podamos ser templos vivientes del Espíritu Santo!*

*Pero Jesús tuvo muchas reacciones negativas por parte de las autoridades judías y querían pruebas de que tenía autoridad de Dios; de lo contrario, ¡dirían que es un farsante!*

*La prueba de Jesús fue simple: ¡era Él mismo! ¡Él es el verdadero Templo que nos hace limpios y un pueblo santo que puede estar con Dios! ¡Él sería la señal que sufriría y moriría en la cruz y resucitaría al tercer día!*

*¡A través de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús, hemos sido reconciliados con Dios y nos hemos hecho hijos e hijas de Dios y nos llenamos con Su Espíritu Santo para que podamos ser templos reales y vivientes de nuestro Dios!*

*¡Que en este tiempo de Cuaresma, seamos conscientes de que Jesús siempre quiere renovar nuestra mente y limpiar nuestro corazón para que podamos ser santos en todo momento y cambiar la forma en que pensamos, actuamos y vivimos como hijo o hija de Dios!*

*Oren por todos aquellos que dirigen la Iglesia, especialmente el Papa Francisco y el obispo Fernandes.*

- *Oren por los afectados por desastres naturales y actos de violencia (Medio Oriente; Ucrania; Burkina Faso; inundaciones y deslizamientos de tierra en el oeste)*

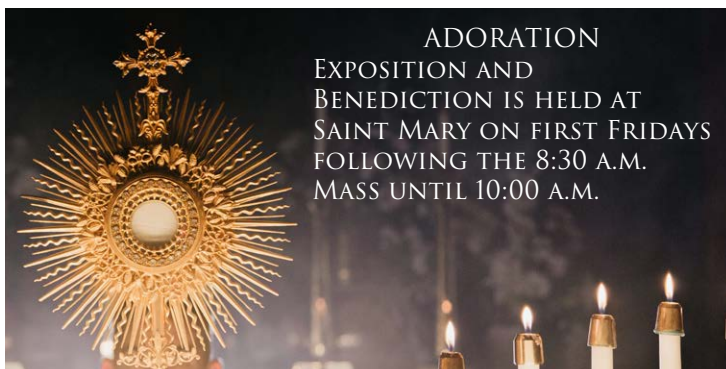
