

FROM THE PRIEST

One of my greatest joys in life are my friends and family, especially young couples. I've known one couple for a while now (I've known the groom since we were kids); married them and most recently, they just had a baby.

For years, I've asked the couple what gives them happiness and security in life. And it's funny how the answer has changed since they've grown up – acquiring all the money and material things that can make them happy; to finding love with another person; and doing whatever it takes for their newborn...

And for some, that can be enough satisfaction for their lives...but, from what I've seen in my life, people are always yearning for more...

In the Gospel this weekend, we see a young man having everything in the world money can buy and enough security that he would never have to look over his shoulder, but he lacked peace and happiness, and who else did he turn to, but Jesus...

The young man did all he could (he even kept all of the commandments), but Jesus sees what's really troubling him – he placed all his peace and happiness on what he had in this world, and Christ wants him to place his peace and happiness on God; God should be his one true possession and treasure.
