FROM THE PRIEST

Growing up, I always had the will to win or to be in first place – whether it be playing a game of basketball, or even a round of math flash cards, I had to have it all! To be recognized by others meant the world to me and I tried as hard as I could to get that recognition.

We see the disciples in this weekend's Gospel try to get that same recognition with Christ. James and John convince their mother to talk to Jesus so they can "sit" in places of recognition next to Him at table.

But recognition and power and authority is flipped upside down with Jesus – He switches the order of first and last and master and servant! Love, sacrifice and humility go with power, authority and position – authority without love is overbearing, position with respect is demeaning and service without humility is cheap.

If we are to serve with Jesus, we should be able to sacrifice our entire lives and able to "drink His cup" – the cup He's talking about was the crucifixion that He was going to endure – for some of us, it's suffering, but for many of us, the cup is striving for holiness in our daily lives, with its sacrifices, disappointments, struggles and temptations.

We should be ready to "lay down our lives" for Christ no matter how big or little sacrifice we endure, and we do this because of love – a love that God has given us in our hearts through the Holy Spirit. May we continue to lay down our lives for Christ and serve others by sharing God's love!

- Pray for Pope Francis and all who lead the Church, especially Bishop Fernandes.
- Pray for those affected by natural disasters and acts of violence (Middle East; Ukraine; floods in Asia; those recovering from Hurricane Helene).
- Pray for Patrick and Jenna Bracken and Dan and Caitlin Foley who were married last Friday and Saturday; may they be blessed, united as one and as they start a family!

DEL SACERDOTE

Al crecer, siempre tuve la voluntad de ganar o de estar en primer lugar, ya sea jugando un partido de baloncesto o incluso una ronda de fichas de matemáticas, ¡tenía que tenerlo todo! Ser reconocido por los demás significaba todo para mí y me esforcé al máximo para obtener ese reconocimiento.

Vemos a los discípulos en el evangelio de este fin de semana tratando de obtener ese mismo reconocimiento con Cristo. Santiago y Juan convencen a su madre de hablar con Jesús para poder "sentarse" en lugares de reconocimiento junto a Él en la mesa.

Pero el reconocimiento, el poder y la autoridad se invierten con Jesús: ¡Él cambia el orden de primero y último y de amo y sirviente! El amor, el sacrificio y la humildad van con el poder, la autoridad y la posición: la autoridad sin amor es autoritaria, la posición con respeto es degradante y el servicio sin humildad es barato.

Si vamos a servir con Jesús, deberíamos ser capaces de sacrificar nuestras vidas enteras y de "beber Su copa" – la copa de la que Él está hablando era la crucifixión que Él iba a soportar – para algunos de nosotros es sufrimiento, pero para muchos de nosotros, la copa es luchar por la santidad en nuestra vida diaria, con sus sacrificios, desilusiones, luchas y tentaciones.

Debemos estar listos para "dar nuestras vidas" por Cristo sin importar cuán grande o pequeño sea el sacrificio que soportemos, y lo hacemos por amor – un amor que Dios nos ha dado en nuestros corazones a través del Espíritu Santo. ¡Que continuemos dando nuestras vidas por Cristo y sirviendo a otros compartiendo el amor de Dios!

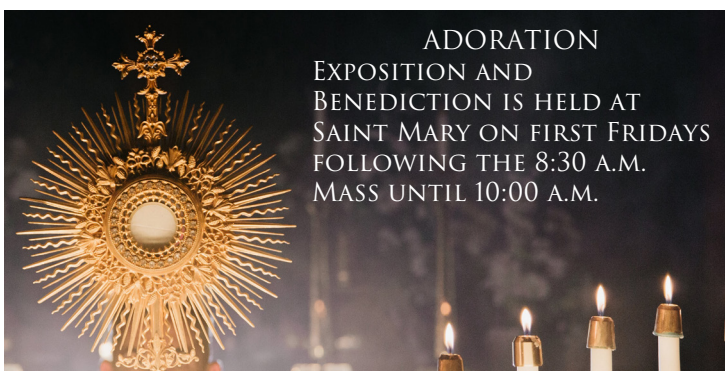

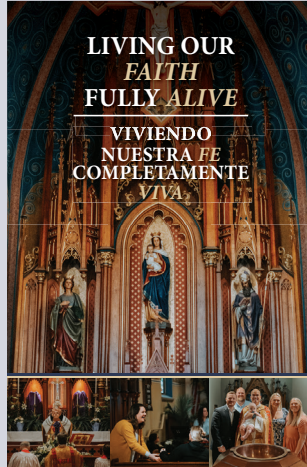
